

Creativity Kits: Give Back to Your Community and Make a Difference in the Lives of Local Children

Thrive Youth Creativity Kits are designed to support the emotional and social wellness of young people. Each kit includes 10 weeks of expert-curated, art-based activities that give children the opportunity to reflect, creatively express themselves, and build self-care habits. The kits also include the supplies needed to complete all the activities, as well as an invitation to access Thrive Youth facilitators by phone for support.

How it Works

Partner with Thrive: Your company signs on to sponsor and pack Creativity Kits, choosing the sponsorship level that works best for you.

Thrive Coordinates Everything: We provide all the kit materials, instructions on packing, and coordinate the local drop-off of the kits to ensure they reach economically disadvantaged children through local community organizations.

Your Employees Pack Kits: We can host an in-person or virtual welcome session for your employees to kick off the packing event.

Distribute Kits: Your team members bring the kits to the local drop-off sites for distribution to kids who need them.



Pricing

Cost Per Kit: \$45, providing one child with arts activity materials and essential school supplies.

Minimum Commitment: A minimum of 50 kits is required (\$2,250 total).

Logistics Included: The cost covers Thrive shipping materials from suppliers to one physical location you designate, plus coordinating drop-off destinations.

Multiple Locations: For supporting multiple communities, the 50-kit minimum applies to each additional physical location.
